

CONFERENCE POLICY: MCGSMUN 2021

Eligibility Criteria:

Delegates must be from classes 9, 10, 11 or 12 and a student of a participating school in order to be deemed eligible to participate in MCGSMUN.

Online Guidelines:

- The entirety of the MCGSMUN will be held on the Zoom platform. Participants will be provided with meeting links before the start of each session. These meeting links must not be shared with any non-participants. If a participant is found sharing these links with a non-participant, they will be expelled from the conference.
- Online communication will take place through Zoom, WhatsApp and Email.
- Participants must name themselves in the following format when joining the online meetings - PORTFOLIO NAME_COMMITTEE.
For example - UNITED STATES OF AMERICA_UNESCO.
- Participants are requested to mute themselves when in session, and if they wish to speak, they may use the 'raise hand' feature and do so after being recognized by the Executive Board.
- Delegates are requested to resolve all technical issues before the conference begins, however if they still face technical issues, they must contact the Executive Board.
- Delegates must be on time for all meetings and committee sessions.
- Certificates of participation will not be provided to delegates who are absent from more than 1 committee session. Exceptions shall be made for medical reasons or other unforeseen circumstances at the discretion of the MCGSMUN Secretariat.
- It is mandatory for the delegates to switch on their videos when they are in committee sessions.
- We request delegates to sit for the conference with a background that causes minimal disturbance.
- The participants are requested to adhere to all of their respective set by the Executive Boards.

Code of Conduct:

1. All delegates must be dressed in formal Western or Indian attire for the entire duration of the Conference. If a delegate's attire is deemed inappropriate he/she will have to leave the Committee Session and change his/her outfit.
2. All delegates are expected to maintain proper attitude during the conference while respecting fellow delegates' ideas, viewpoints and opinions.
3. All delegates are expected to behave very professionally and courteously with the Executive Board, co-delegates and members of the Organizing Committee. All delegates are expected to not convey any indecent or undiplomatic remarks to the Executive Board, co-delegates or the Organizing Committee members.
4. MCGSMUN will not tolerate any instances of harassment, discrimination based on race, gender, sexual orientation, caste, creed, religion, nationality etc. Further if anyone feels that they have encountered harassment, or discrimination, resulting in a hostile working environment, must report the incident to the Secretary General or any Member of the Secretariat. To which the secretariat will take appropriate action after investigation.

Media Policy:

By signing the indemnity form and attending MCGSMUN, participants consent to being photographed and recorded while in committee by the MCGS staff, and authorize MCGS to use these screenshots or recordings in any manner of MCGSMUN's choosing. Participants are not allowed to publish recordings or photographs of proceedings of the conference without obtaining consent from Mayo College Girls' School, Ajmer.

Participant Contact Information:

Every participant will be required to submit their Name, Email ID and Phone Number to the secretariat before the conference begins.

Plagiarism Policy:

Plagiarism in any form will not be tolerated in MCGSMUN. If a delegate is found submitting plagiarized matter, they will immediately be expelled from the conference.

Refund Policy:

If a delegate wishes to withdraw their participation, they must do so latest by 31st August, 2021. If they fail to do so by the deadline, they will not be given a refund.

Award Policy:

The decision of the Executive Board regarding the awards shall be considered final and no objections will be entertained. Delegates must understand that a comprehensive marking system has been formulated and the decision regarding awards shall be respected.
